- b) Superintendent's Report

RAINFALL: 2.78" of precipitation fell at the Mosquito Commission yard in the month of January.

WATER MANAGEMENT: Basin reconditioning involving heavy equipment continued in Jackson Township off Nighthawk Lane.

Small crews continue to clear ditches, creeks, and basin grates throughout the County when the weather cooperates. This winter has not been as kind as our previous one so projects have been limited over the past month.

GROUND LARVICIDING: Our inspectors are currently involved with route review/revision and testing out our new tablets and software. Very positive comments are coming in about the tablets and we should be ready to go in March!

OTHER: Our annual audit for the past years financial information has begun. The audit is mostly virtual this year, which has been interesting, but we are working together in the best way to provide our information over to the accountants.

Special Use Permits have been applied for with the USFWS Edwin B. Forsythe National Refuge for Aerial Mosquito Inspection and Larviciding.

The 2021 NJMCA Annual Convention is going to be a virtual event this year and will be held on March 17th and 18th. There is no charge for attending the convention but there are certain computer/device requirements that must be met to participate and receive

credits. The annual Pesticide Training Session will also be virtual and will be held on March 30th.
